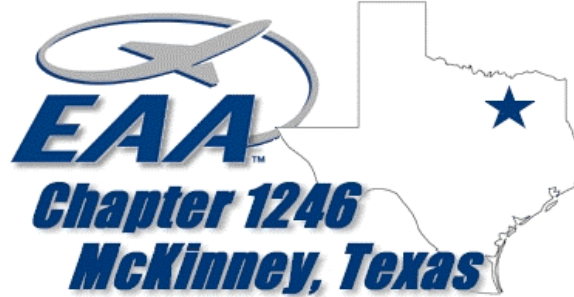
Painting Your Airplane

According to Ken, the actual process of painting is not that difficult. The key is in preparing the surface; that is where all the time and work is involved.
